# June 4-8, 2018

Camp Canaan is for kids entering 1st through 8th grades, ages 6-14.

Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. each day. You must sign campers in each day and note who will be picking them up in the afternoon. After a fun filled day of activities, your child must be picked up promptly at 4 p.m. They must be signed out by the person picking them up along with picking up any medications or important papers noting changes that may occur that week. Your child's safety is very important to us. **Please be on time!**

## What to wear/bring

Modest dress is required by adults / kids and will be strictly enforced.


- **OK:** jeans, capris, shorts (to tip of finger with hand hanging loosely by the side), tee shirts, athletic shoes
- **NOT OK:** see-through, skin tight, foul language, inappropriate logos, tank-tops, mid-drifts, short shorts (including athletic style shorts), flimsy flip flops, and shirts that are too low neck, etc.
- **Shoes must be worn at all times.** (Tennis shoes recommended.)
- **Jewelry & other valuables are not recommended at camp**, as they can be lost or damaged and we will not be held responsible.
- **Sunscreen or bug repellent** may be applied daily before coming to camp.



**Sack lunch and drink are to be brought each day of camp marked clearly with camper's name and grade.**

- Snacks will be provided for morning and evening times.
- Water is always available to everyone.

Camp is fun but a few rules are necessary for fun and enjoyment by all.



- Campers agree to follow all instructions given by camp staff.
- Respect should be obvious in words and actions at all times.
- Tobacco, drugs, knives, guns, fire works, lighters, and foul language will not be tolerated or allowed.
- Campers must stay with their groups, in designated areas, and attend all activities unless they have permission from director or assistant director.



All medications must be dropped off with note at sign-in each day and will be kept and administered by camp nurse only. Please note all medical issues/ handicaps on registration form. All health and medical expenses are the parent's/guardian's responsibility.
